Commissioner Jimmar offered the invocation. Chairman Gardiner passed the gavel to Commissioner Jimmar to serve eight months as Chairman.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Burleson made motion to approve Consent Agenda. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Gardiner and passed with all Commissioners voting aye.
