Colbert County Commission met today in regular session at the Colbert County Courthouse. Chairman Creekmore called the meeting to order at 4:55 P.M. with all Commissioners being present. Commissioner Hovater offered the invocation.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Gardiner made motion to approve the consent agenda with a second by Commissioner Burleson. Consent agenda was passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

1. Approved minutes of August 6, 2013 Commission meeting.
2. Approved payment of bills as presented.
3. Approved request from Sheriff to declare 2008 Ford as surplus due to high mileage and cost of repairs.
4. Approved request by Commissioner Burleson to remove timber at Colbert Alloys Park for something to be done at a later date. This would allow for more parking and provide view from the pavilion.
5. Approved 15,920.29 for payment of bills for replacement of compressor and repairs to air condition unit at Courthouse. The damage to the unit was due to lightning; therefore it was deemed an emergency. Parts were ordered and quotes for installation of parts and repair were received. First Service Heating and Air Conditioning had the low quote of 2,800.00 and J. C. Hamm and Sons quoted 3,240.00.

In other business, Commissioners directed County Engineer to cut approximately 50 feet on roadside at intersection of Jarmon Lane and County Line Road. This request was made due a sight issue at the intersection.

Commissioners directed County Administrator to inform Sheriff that salaries, personnel benefits, and fuel would continue to be approved for payment, but all other expenditures will need to be brought to the Commission for approval in the Sheriff Department Budget, due to the department expenditures being over budget.

With no further business, Commissioner Gardiner made motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Burleson seconded the motion and all Commissioners concurred.
