3. Approved resolution for fee schedule for Colbert County Health Department as presented by Dr. Karen Landers. The schedule reflects no changes from the previous year.
4. Approved administration of \$5,000 grant for the juvenile probation office as requested by Judge Chad Coker.

5. Approved letter to Colbert County Board of Education stating that Colbert County Household Garbage will backup Board of Education garbage pickup in event that their truck is unable to pick up garbage at schools.
6. Approved proclamation of Pro Bono Week 2013, from October 20 to 26, 2013, sponsored by the Alabama State Bar. This proclamation was submitted by Chad Smith.
7. Approved renaming Belle Vista Subdivision Phase 1 to The Woods at Wilson Phase I.
8. Approved annual bids submitted to County Road Department and opened on September 11, 2013. The bid results are attached to these minutes.
9. Approved adoption of Colbert County Clean Highway Program to be administrated by Solid Waste Officer George Kimbrough. The program will allow the Court to assign highway clean-up as a sentence and reduce payment amount.
10. Approved purchase of ad for 2013 NCAA Men's Division I Football National Championship in the amount of 950.00 to Jerry Knight Sports Advertising.
11. Approved RSVP Budget of 132,383.00 as submitted.
12. Approved Drug Task Force Grant Budget application as submitted, with exception of adding percent of Financial Officer's salary to be included in the application.
13. Approved NACOLG/Department of Aging Services agreement for East Colbert Senior Center to be administrated by Colbert County Commission.
14. Approved letter to be sent to Colbert County Board of Education, requesting no-cost, long-term lease of property for storm shelter project. The property is located across from Colbert Heights High School at the intersection of Burton Road and Sunset Drive.
15. Approved transfer of funds from Capital Improvement in the amount of 35,294.98 into General Fund. The amount is money that has been paid out for improvement of County property from the General Fund.
16. Approved holding deposit of funds received for sale of Barton property until decision is made by Commissioners on where they want to deposit the funds.
17. Accepted report from County Engineer John Bedford that he had run temporary water lines to reconnect to Muscle Shoals for development of CVC. Mr. Bedford informed Commission that he had requested reimbursement from SIDC for temporary water lines.

With no further business, Commissioner Hovater made motion to adjourn the meeting with a second from Commissioner Burlison. All Commissioners concurred.
