Colbert County Commission met today in regular session at the Colbert County Courthouse with all Commissioners being present. Chairman Creekmore called the meeting to order at 5:50 P.M. Commissioner Gardiner offered the invocation.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Black made motion to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Gardiner seconded the motion. The motion passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

1. Approved the minutes of February 4, 2014 Commissioner meeting.
2. Approved payment of bills as presented and payment of additional bills to Jim South for total amount of 2,491.00 for concrete work at Storm Shelters sidewalk at Colbert Alloys Park pavilion.
3. Approved County Levies for Alcohol Licensing for 2014-2015 as required by Sec. 28-3A-4. This requires Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to collect all county license fees new license applications and renewed licenses.
4. Approved request by Sheriff Ronnie May to surplus 2003 Ford Patrol Car.
5. Approved request by Revenue Commission Tommy Oswalt the hiring of Appraisal Trainee Jeremy Heath Terry. The starting annual salary is 24,445.00, which is the salary for an appraiser.
6. Approved request to surplus 1996 Ford Truck which has been used by Courthouse Maintenance.
7. Approved bid submitted by Harris Company for purchase of accounting software program for County Commission Office. This was the lowest bid received. The result of bids are:

Harris	65,242.00	8,555.00 annual maint.
8. Approved proposal from Williams Electric in the amount of 7,787.89 for installation of 600 amp breaker panel for annex. This is necessary for Jail and EMA/911 to function safely and without power outage.
9. Approved request by County Engineer John Bedford to spend up to 5,000 for engineering study to determine future need for sewer system at intersection of 3 Mile Lane and Highway 20.
