Commissioner Gardiner offered the invocation. Chairman Creekmore passed the Gavel to Commissioner Hovater to serve the next 8 months as Chairman of the Commission.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Creekmore made motion to approve consent agenda. Commissioner Gardiner seconded the motion. The motion passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

1. Approved minutes of the February 18, 2014 Commission meeting.
2. Approved payment of bills as presented with a change in payment to Williams Electric being paid from Capital Improvement instead of General Fund in the amount of 1.307.41.
3. Approved proposal for sewer at storm shelters located at Barton, Colbert Heights School, LaGrange Road/Waldrep Loop, Allsboro, Crooked Oak, LaGrange/Colburn Mountain, Hatton School, and Second Street/River Road. Proposal was submitted by Larry Black, PE/LS and recommended by County Engineer John Bedford.
4. Approved purchase of 2.4 acres of property located beside Ford City Storm Shelter for site of new Senior Center building. Commissioner Burleson presented the request and has commitment of grant money for the purchase of the land. Commissioner Burleson is working to obtain grant money to use for the building of the Senior Center.

With no further business, Commissioner Gardiner made motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Creekmore seconded the motion and all Commissioners concurred.
