1. Approved minutes of the March 4, 2014 Commission meeting.
2. Approved payment of bills as presented.
3. Approved awarding of bid for liquid asphalt to Hunt for 480.75 per ton. Other bids were Ergon for 498.20 per ton and Vulcan for 502.90 per ton.
4. Approve purchase of Ad “The Miracle Worker” for 140.00 to be paid to Helen Keller Garden Club.
5. Approved lease agreement with Colbert County Board of Education for use of property for storm shelter at Colbert Heights. Copy of lease is part of these minutes.
6. Approved job description for Commission office Secretary/Receptionist for starting salary beginning at 10.06 per hour. This position will be advertised in house to County employees.
7. Approved purchase of Ad for Colbert County Sports Hall of Fame. The ad is for a full page ad in program for 600.00.
8. Approved request for payment of annual leave in the amount of 514.50 to Jonna DeVaney.
9. Approved payment of 514.80 for advertising of local bill as requested by Safeplace.
10. Approved Fuel bid contract renewal to Tatum Oil, based on average price for 12 month period to begin April 1, 2014 and extend through March 31, 2015.
