Colbert County Commission met today in regular session at the Colbert County Courthouse. Chairman Hovater called the meeting to order at 6:10 P.M. Commissioner Creekmore was no present. All other Commissioners were present. Commissioner Jimmar offered the invocation.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Burleson made motion to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Gardiner seconded the motion and the motion passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

1. Approved minutes of March 18, 2014 Commission meeting with corrections.
2. Approved payment of bills as presented.
3. Approved appropriation of funding to Wilson Lakes Shores turn lane to a by-pass lane to include Alabama Lake Shores. The cost will be the same as approved previously for one turn lane.
4. Approved Proclamation for “Don’t Drop It On Alabama”, which proclaims the week of April 19-26, 2014 as a spring cleanup program dedicated to keeping Colbert County a litter free community.
5. Approved request from Sheriff to hire contract Deputies Frank Katic and Robert Thole for 90 days.
6. Approved request from Sheriff to hire contract jailers Brandon Withers and Jacob Wilbanks for 90 days.

In other business, Chairman Hovater reported on a meeting concerning the security system of the Courthouse and some steps the County Commission can take to make the Courthouse safer for the employees and citizens that are in the Courthouse. Evaluation and recommendations are being compiled and a report will presented in the near future.

Mr. Robert Mitchell and Mr. Buster Smith presented an update on the Energy Audit for County buildings. This audit was approved at a previous meeting. They will present a report upon completion of the project.

With no further business, Commissioner Burleson made motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Black seconded the motion and all Commissioners concurred.
