Colbert County Commission met today at the Colbert County Courthouse. Chairman Hovater called the meeting to order at 5:59 P.M. with all Commissioners present. Commissioner Black offered the invocation.

PUBLIC HEARING LOVE'S TRAVEL STOP LIQUOR LICENSE

Chairman Hovater called the Public Hearing to order for Love's Travel Stop 580 located at 2048 Highway 20 Tuscumbia. The application was for Retail Beer (Off Premises Only) and Retail Table Wine (Off Premises Only). Chairman Hovater called for anyone to speak in support of the license. No one responded. Chairman called a second time for anyone in support of the license. No one responded. Chairman Hovater called a third and final time for anyone to speak in support of the license. No one responded. Chairman Hovater called for anyone to speak against the liquor license. No one responded. Chairman called a second time for any against the license. No one responded. Commissioner Creekmore made motion to approve license for Love's Travel Stop 580, located at Highway 20 Tuscumbia. Commissioner Burleson seconded the motion. The motion passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Creekmore made motion to approve consent agenda. Commissioner Gardiner seconded the motion and all Commissioners voted aye.

1. Approved payment of bills as presented.
2. Approved appointment of NACOLG non-elected Board Members for 1 year term to Ollie Underwood, Teresa Rogers, Tyson Johnson, and Margaret Lovett.
3. Approved agreement with ThinkGard for Backup/Disaster Recovery Managed BDR Services Proposal recommended by Data Processing Manager Johnny Thompson. These are services that backup the data and store it in an offsite location, so that in the event of a disaster the information can be retrieved through internet and prevent permanent loss of information. The cost will be divided between the Commission and Reappraisal Maintenance fund.

4. Approved the job description and advertising for Water Clerk position requested by County Engineer John Bedford. Mr. Bedford explained that this position was an approved position, but had not been filled and he would be advertising and then hiring someone for this position.
5. Approved request by County Engineer John Bedford to declare as surplus a 2011 Kubota 4 X 4 tractor.
6. Approved starting renovation of County existing building currently known as County barn located on Hickory Street in Tuscumbia. County Maintenance employees will begin with cleaning out interior of building for future renovation. This project will include the destruction of tractor barn and shed located on County barn property.

Commissioner Creekmore made motion to approve minutes of October 21, 2014 Commission. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Black. Commissioner Gardiner abstained due to not being present at that meeting. All other Commissioners voted aye.

CERTIFYING VOTERS LIST PAYMENT

Commissioner Gardiner made motion to approve payment for certifying voters list in the amount of 1,718.75 requested by Probate Judge Rosser. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Black. The motion passed with Commissioners Burleson, Black, Hovater, and Gardiner voting aye. Commissioners Jimmar and Creekmore voted nay.
