Colbert County Commission met today in Regular Session at the Colbert County Courthouse. Chairman Burleson called the meeting to order at 4:34 P.M. with all Commissioners present, except Commissioner Jimmar. Commissioner Black offered the invocation.

PUBLIC HEARING – LIQUOR LICENSE

Chairman Burleson called the Public Hearing to order for liquor license application for Cozumel Mexicano Grill located at 8255 2nd Street, Leighton, Alabama 35646. Chairman Burleson called for anyone to speak for the liquor license application. No response. Chairman called second time to speak for license. No response. Chairman called for anyone to speak for third and final time. No response. Chairman Burleson called for anyone to speak against liquor license. No response. Chairman called for anyone to speak against second time. No response. Chairman called for anyone to speak against for third and final time. No response. Commissioner Creekmore made motion to approve liquor license application for Cozumel Mexicano Grill, located at 8255 2nd Street, Leighton. Commissioner Gardiner seconded the motion. The motion passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Hovater made motion to approve consent agenda. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Creekmore. All Commissioners voted aye to pass the motion.

1. Approved recommended proposal for Mappers and Appraisers pay scale guideline to allow for increase in salary for completion of certification program. This was presented and recommended by Commissioner Gardiner.
2. Approved incentive based certification payment to be made 1 time annually if and when the payment is received by the County. The payment to the employee will be one half of the amount received by County for a maximum of 5,000.
3. Approved revision of Drug Task Force grant budget. This revision was made due to a decrease in the Grant funding from ADECA.
4. Approved Mr. Tim Leigh as appointment to Helen Keller Hospital Board of Directors. Mr. Leigh was nominated by Commissioner Black.
5. Approved 2015 Holiday Schedule for Courthouse closings.

6. Approved resolution and grant administration for NACOLG to administer Senior Citizen Center new building project on River Road.
7. Approved request for extension on Abatement for Wise Alloys.
8. Approved position for Solid Waste Officer to be a part time position with maximum salary of 23,000 annually without benefits.
9. Approved resolution authorizing Commission Chairman to make decision if necessary for Courthouse to be closed for inclement weather or other unforeseen emergencies.
10. Approved transfer of annual leave donated by Jai Triplett in Road Department to sick leave for Julie Triplett in Water Department. The amount of leave transferred was 4 hours.
11. Approved December 16, 2014 as date set for Public Hearing for liquor license application for Foodland located on County Line Road, Muscle Shoals.

With no further business, Commissioner Hovater made motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Gardiner and all Commissioners concurred.
