Colbert County Commission met today in regular session at the Colbert County Courthouse. Chairman Black called the meeting to order at 6:05 P.M. with all Commissioners present. Commissioner Hovater offered the invocation.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Hovater made motion to approve the consent agenda. Commissioner Burleson seconded the motion. The motion passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

1. Approved the minutes of August 11, 2015 Commission meeting.
2. Approved payment of bills as presented and additional bills to Overton Garage for \$1,600 and Tennessee Valley Authority for \$342.92.
3. Awarded bid to Integrated Corporate Solutions for IBM Power 8 System for \$45,503.00 to be paid out of Reappraisal Maintenance Fund. This was the only bid received.
4. Approved request from C. D. Patterson for County to purchase 10 tons of lime delivered to Cherokee Forever Wild Land and clear land for shooting house to be placed.
5. Approved \$15,000 Grant for part time secretarial assistant for Juvenile Probation office. The grant is through Administration Office of Courts.
6. Approved request from County Engineer John Bedford to declare Water Department F-150 Truck as surplus.
7. Awarded bid to Integrated Corporate Solutions, Inc. for \$3,345.70 for server needed for Commission office. This was the only bid submitted. This will be paid out of General Fund.
8. Approved payment of \$1,133.90 requested by Angela Puckett for unused accumulated annual leave.
9. Approved part time employment for Donna Ricks. Mrs. Ricks will be employed temporary to assist Commission office with insurance, work compensation, and safety duties as needed during vacancy of the full time position left vacant by resignation of Angela Puckett.
10. Approved meeting to be held on September 15, 2015 at 4:00 P.M. before the next regular meeting. This meeting will address the budget and energy study update.

With no further business, Commissioner Hovater made motion to adjourn the meeting. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Creekmore. All Commissioners concurred.
