Colbert County Commission met today in regular session at the Colbert County Courthouse. Chairman Gardiner called the meeting to order at 5:38 PM with all Commissioners present. Commissioner Black offered the invocation.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Creekmore made motion to approve consent agenda.

Commissioner Hovater seconded the motion and all Commissioners voted aye.

1. Approved payment of bills as presented.
2. Approved resolution and agreement for National Voter Registration Act which authorizes the Secretary of State's Office to act as the county's agent for purposes of paying postage required for the mailing of voter notices for voter file maintenance required by Code of Alabama 1975, section 17-4-30.
3. Approved contract agreements for municipal inmates housed in the County Jail. The agreements require payment from Cities of Muscle Shoals and Sheffield of \$23 per day per inmate and for Leighton, Littleville, and Cherokee to pay \$13 per day per inmate.
4. Approved internet service for Rose Trail Park for \$59 per month for 60 months with Cherokee Telephone System.
5. Approved public works contract with Butler Construction, Inc. for the improvement and construction of the removal and replacement of the roof, wall panels, trim and gutters of the Colbert County Shop. The project is not to exceed \$82,100.
6. Approved request by Probate Judge Daniel Rosser for changes in the following voting locations:

7. Approved electrical change to shed at Rose Trail Park. Increased electrical power will be installed to allow use of heavy equipment to be used.
8. Approved job description for Information Technology/Network Administrator in grade 13 on the payscale. Eugene Rikard was promoted to this position upon the retirement of Johnny Thompson effective June 1, 2016. Mr. Rikard will receive an increase of \$12,000 per year for the new position, which includes Reappraisal Maintenance department servers previously outsourced.
9. Approved professional services agreement with ICS for 100 hours at \$60 per hour. The services would serve as a backup to IT/Network Administrator in his absence or if additional services are required.

Commissioner Burleson made motion to approve minutes of April 19, 2016 Commission meeting. Commissioner Creekmore seconded the motion. Commissioner Black abstained from the vote and all other Commissioners voted aye passing the motion.

With no further business, Commissioner Hovater made motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Creekmore seconded the motion and all Commissioners concurred.
