Colbert County Commission met today in regular session at the Colbert County Courthouse. Chairman Gardiner called the meeting to order at 5:23 pm with all Commissioners present. Commissioner Hovater offered the invocation.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Creekmore made motion to approve consent agenda.

Commissioner Black seconded the motion. The motion passes with all Commissioners voting aye.

1. Approved minutes from May 3, 2016 Commission meeting.
2. Approved payment of bills as presented.
3. Approved resolution for 200 Alabama Bicentennial, which recognizes the history and anniversary of State of Alabama for 200 years. This period, 2017 to 2019, is a time of reflection and commemoration and presents a unique opportunity to celebrate and spotlight the State during this milestone.
4. Approved Chairman's signature requested by Revenue Commissioner Oswald for paperwork to settle 2015 taxes with State.
5. Approved employment of Deputy to supervise Litter Crew. Litter crew will consist of jail inmates that have been approved by Judge and Sheriff to work on roadside. Sheriff and Administrator will develop job description and bring back to Commission for approval.
6. Approved purchase of white goods truck for \$134,455 to replace truck that burned. The new truck will be purchase through purchasing co-op. Insurance Company deemed the truck a total loss.
7. Approved Southern Environmental Engineering to provide services to test water runoff for Solid Waste for \$600. This will start process to renew application for ADEM permit.

Commissioner Creekmore addressed the loss of the white goods truck and the fact that the employees in the truck were unharmed. Appreciation goes to Spring Valley Volunteer Fire Department for their services in extinguishing and containing the fire.

June 7, 2016 was set for Civil Service Board hearing requested by an employee in Sheriff's department. The hearing will immediately follow the regular Commission meeting that date.

With no further business, Commissioner Burleson made motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Creekmore seconded the motion and all Commissioners concurred.
