Commissioner Black seconded the motion. The motion passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

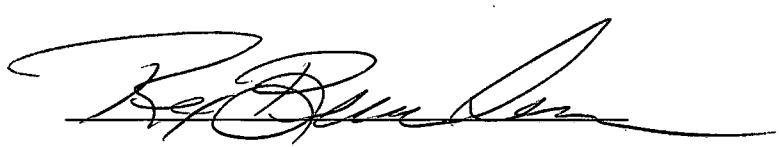
1. Approved revised job description for Deputy on Litter Crew. The position is under the supervision of the Sheriff with work orders to be given by Solid Waste Supervisor.
