Colbert County Commission met today in regular session at the Colbert County Courthouse with all Commissioners present. Chairman Gardiner called the meeting to order at 5:34 p.m. Commissioner Hovater offered the invocation.

Mr. Kelly Aday, President of Colbert County Association Volunteer Fire Departments addressed the Commission. Mr. Aday thanked the Commissioners for the support given to the 14 Volunteer Fire Departments in Colbert County and requested additional funding for the next fiscal year.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Burleson made motion to approve consent agenda. Commissioner Black seconded the motion. The motion passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

1. Approved minutes of July 19, 2016 Commission meeting.
2. Approved payment of bills as presented to Commission.
3. Approved Tax Abatement Agreement for 510 Mulberry Lane, LLC and RMR-Barton, LLC. This is for a new construction located at 510 Mulberry Lane, Cherokee, Alabama and is for abatement of all state and local non-educational property taxes. A copy of the agreement is spread upon the minutes.
4. Approved Agreement with Alabama Administrative Office of Courts for \$15,000 grant to allow Ms. Debbie Fisher employment to enter data in the Court Improvement Program Access Application to collect dependency and termination-of-rights information. The grant will be under the supervision of Judge Coker.
5. Approved grant application for Drug Task Force requesting \$50,000. The request is for continuation of Colbert County Drug Task Force for period of October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.
6. Approved request for payment of unused annual leave for Mark Moore in the amount of \$642.20. Mr. Moore resigned as Sheriff's Deputy effective August 7, 2016.

- 7. Approved request to adjust salary of Jacob Wilbanks to \$20,911.00. Mr. Wilbanks is a full time Jailer and the adjustment will make his pay in line with current Jailer's salary.
- 8. Approved request by Probate Judge Rosser for promotion of Pat Gargis to supervisor of the records effective upon the retirement of Becky Fuller on October 1, 2016.
- 9. Approved request by Probate Judge Rosser to hire and start a new tag clerk employee 2 weeks before Mary Rorie's resignation is effective on August 31, 2016.

With no further business, Commissioner Creekmore made motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Burleson seconded the motion and all Commissioners concurred.
