Commissioner Creekmore made motion to approve consent agenda. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Black. All Commissioners voted aye and the motion passed.


1. Approved minutes of August 2, 2016 Commission meeting.
2. Approved awarding bid to Butler Construction was renovation of Courthouse doors as recommended by Brad Bernard, Architect with Create Architects. The bids are as follows:

Hovater Construction	73,782.00
3. Approved request from Steven Myre for payment of annual leave in the amount of 1,219.16. Resignation was effective August 6, 2016.
4. Approved purchase of two animal cages at Animal Control to be designated for residents in the County area. Cages will cost \$180.00 each.
5. Approved purchase of half page ad for 1,659.00 in Business Alabama publication.
6. Approved request from NACOLG for payment of invoice for administrative costs for safe rooms project in amount of 24,744.30.
7. Approved request from Probate Judge to declare as surplus miscellaneous computer equipment that has been updated and is not currently in use.
8. Approved request from Sheriff Frank Williamson for additional funds up to \$12,000 for equipment.


