Colbert County Commission met today in Regular Session at the Colbert County Courthouse. Chairman Gardiner called the meeting to order at 5:27 p.m. with all Commissioners present. Commissioner Hovater offered the invocation.

CONSENT AGENDA

Commissioner Black made motion to approve consent agenda. Commission Hovater seconded the motion. The motion passed with all Commissioners voting aye.

1. Approved payment of bills as presented.
2. Approved agreement with Mobilities Cellular Service presented by Richard Frier for license agreement to provide data access by installing equipment on County right of way. The pole for equipment will be placed on Haley Drive. The County will receive compensation for the license at rate of 4 per cent and the funds will be deposited into the General Fund.
3. Approved request by Nathan Bougher for payment of annual leave. The amount of the request is \$329.28.
4. Approved request by Becky Fuller for payment of annual leave. The amount of the request is \$886.39.
5. Approved payment of invoice requested by Siemens for energy savings project. The invoice was for amount of \$399,645.00.
6. Approved request for Colbert Heights High School Agricultural Department to utilize unused portion of property at Storm Shelter. The Agriculture Department will plant a garden and the community will have access to the garden.
7. Approved Severe Weather Preparedness Tax Free Holiday for February 24, 2017 thru February 26, 2017.
8. Approved North Alabama Highway Safety Grant requested by Sheriff Williamson. The Grant is used for paying overtime to Deputies on patrol.
9. Approved request for tax abatement of state and local non-educational property taxes and all construction-related taxes, except those levied for educational purposes and except the 0.15% general sales and use taxes

levied by Colbert County, which pursuant to Alabama Act NO. 2007-351 cannot be abated, for Gravlee Real Estate Holdings, LLC and Life Data Solar, LLC located in West Colbert County. Mr. Darryl Spencer and Ms. Tammy Irons presented the information and request to the County Commission. The request is for a 10 year abatement period.

10. Approved an appropriation of \$750.00 to Town of Littleville for the Blue Grass Festival requested by Commissioner Creekmore.
11. Approved request by County Engineer John Bedford to start the new employee for the Meter Reader position at the Water Department two weeks early. The time is a training period for the new employee.

Commissioner Creekmore made motion to approve minutes of September 20, 2016 regular Commission meeting. Commissioner Burleson seconded the motion. District 2 Commissioner Black and District 4 Commissioner Jimmar abstains from the vote, due to their absence at that meeting. The motion passed with all other Commissioners voting aye.

With no further business, Commissioner Creekmore made motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Burleson seconded the motion. All Commissioners concurred.

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
