

White Goods Roadside Pickup Service

In a continuing effort to keep our County clean, the Colbert County Commission provides for the operation of three trucks for **White Goods Roadside Pickup Service**. As Spring Cleaning time is upon us the number of pick-ups, made daily by our trucks, dramatically increases.

In order to continue to operate as efficiently as possible we ask for your cooperation in observing the following rules regarding the Roadside Pickup Service:

- Items should be placed at a residential dwelling; adjoining the County Right Of Way in a manner as not to pose a danger to traffic, while providing access for the trucks.
- Household goods such as mattresses, refrigerators, T.Vs, washers etc. are allowed.
- **LIMBS OVER 8 FEET SHOULD BE CUT** into smaller pieces to allow for pickup.
- **LEAVES AND GRASS CLIPPINGS MUST BE BOXED OR BAGGED.**
- Yard debris and shrubs are allowed.

Items **NOT** allowed under the Roadside Pickup Service include:

- Tires
- Batteries
- Construction Company or Commercially Generated debris
- Bio-Hazardous materials
- No grass clippings or leaves not bagged or boxed.

To avoid erosion and overflow of ditches onto roads please do not place items in drainage ditches.

Roadside Pickup Service is not allowed on State Highways, therefore the County will not pick up on State Right-Of-Ways.
