Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the Colbert County Commission 09/19/2023

The Colbert County Commission met today in regular session at the Colbert County Courthouse. Chairman Mansell called the work session to order at 5:04 p.m. with the regular meeting following at 5:24 p.m., being the time and place previously scheduled for such work session and regular meeting. All Commissioners answered "present" at the call of the roll. EMA Director Michael Smith offered the prayer and led the Pledge of Allegiance. CONSENT AGENDA

Chairman Mansell announced that the business before the Commission was the approval of the consent agenda. Commissioner Gardiner made a motion to adopt and approve the matters placed on the consent agenda during the work session. The motion was duly seconded by Commissioner Barnes. Chairman Mansell stated that the adoption and approval of a consent agenda comprised of the following items of business was properly before the Commission and stated the matters as follows:

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2023-0038

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CLOSURE OF THE "WATER METER FUND" ACCOUNT AND TRANSFER OF ASSETS IN SUCH ACCOUNT TO THE "WATER GROSS REVENUE FUND" ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, there currently exists a bank account held by Colbert County known as the "Water Meter Fund" which holds funds required to be deposited by water customers to obtain a water meter; and

WHEREAS, the Water Meter Fund is also used to refund water customers the amount paid by the customer for deposit when such deposit is no longer required; and

WHEREAS, there currently exists a bank account held by Colbert County known as the Water Gross Revenue Fund which is used as the main operating account for the Colbert County Water Department; and

WHEREAS, the Commission is desirous of closing the Water Meter Fund and transferring the current balance of the account to the Water Gross Revenue Fund account while continuing to account for customer paid deposits; and

WHEREAS, the Commission finds that the closure of the Water Meter Fund will not adversely affect Water Department operations and will have the benefit of reducing the number of accounts required to operate the Water Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Colbert County Commission that the bank account known as the Water Meter Fund be closed and the current balance of the account be transferred to the bank account known as the Water Gross Revenue Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that current records of customer deposited funds shall be maintained and continue to be accounted for in the same manner as done prior to the adoption of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that April Eaton, as the Chief Financial Officer of Colbert County, be in she is hereby authorized to take such action as she in her sole discretion deems necessary, advisable, and convenient to close the Water Meter Fund bank account and transfer the balance of such account to the Water Gross Revenue Fund bank account.
